Dear Guy,

The end of the year has come and the first Nissan Leafs and the first GM Volts have been delivered. The first Leaf went to San Francisco Bay Area resident Olivier Chalouhi. At a special presentation at North Bay Nissan of Petaluma in California, Chalouhi, a 31-year-old Silicon Valley entrepreneur who was the first person in the U.S. to order a Leaf. He took possession of a black LEAF SL in what Nissan described as an historic event representing "the first delivery of an affordable, mass-market, all-electric car since the first days of the automotive era." Also in California, a retired airline pilot by the name of Jeffrey Kaffee has become the first customer in the U.S. to take delivery of a Chevrolet Volt. Although the Volt he received wasn't actually the first available for sale - that particular vehicle went to the winner of an online charity auction, which closed with a winning bid of US\$225,000. Proceeds of the auction will go to the Detroit Public School Foundation. Kaffee of Parsippany, New Jersey, cut his vacation short to become the first customer to take possession of a Volt on December 15 at Gearhart Chevrolet in Denville, New Jersey. His vehicle was one of 360 Volts to leave the Detroit-Hammtramck Assembly Plant this week aboard a caravan of car carriers headed for initial launch markets that include California, Texas, Washington D.C. and New York.

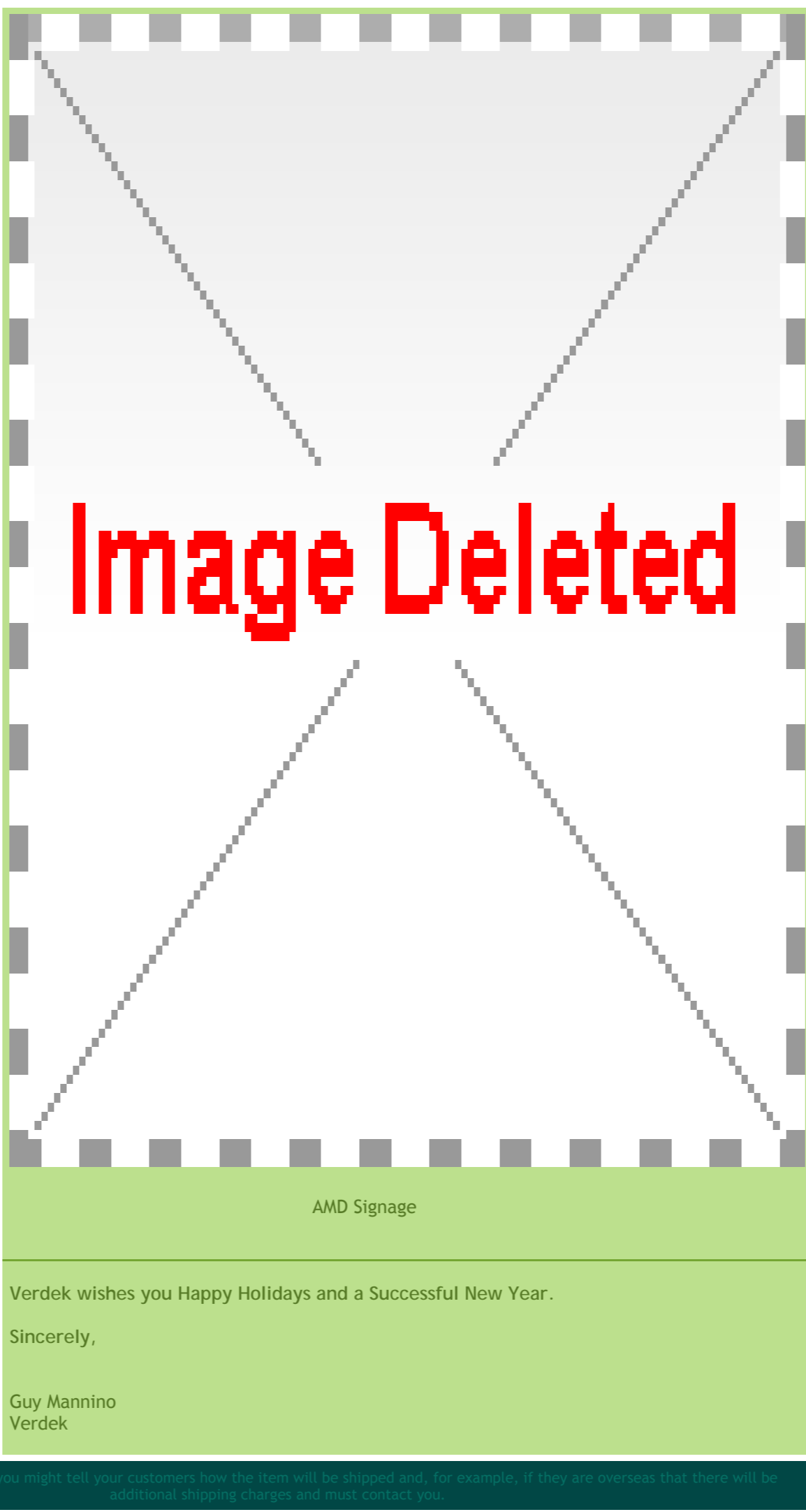
